

Privacy Policy

In the privacy policy references to 'we' or 'us' refer to **Tenbury Town Council, The Pump Rooms, Teme Street, Tenbury Wells, Worcestershire, WR15 8BA**. This policy will explain what information we collect about you and how we use it.

We will collect:

Any personal details you type in and submit, such as name, address, email address, etc. We will use this to provide you with relevant information in the future.

Data which allows us to recognise you, your preferences, and how you use this website. This saves you from re-entering information when you return to the site. This data is collected by cookies from your navigation around the site. A cookie is a small amount of data which we send to your computer. The data is then stored on your browser or hard disk. Details about disabling these cookies can normally be found in the Help facility provided with your browser. Your IP address (this is your computer's individual identification number) which is automatically logged by our web server. This is used to note your interest in our website. It is also possible that we will use your IP address to help diagnose problems on our web site.

By submitting your information you consent to the use of that information as set out in this policy. If for any reason our policy does change, we will post the changes on this page so you can view them. If changes occur with which you are unhappy, you can email us with and instruct us to no longer use your information.

It is not possible for us to predict the route which the information will travel (due to the Internet's infrastructure being a global one); this means your information may be temporarily transferred outside the European Economic Area. By submitting your information you consent to this transfer.

We will not sell, rent, or pass on your information to any third parties without your express consent.

By submitting your information and using our web site, you consent to the collection, storage and processing of your personal information by us in the manner set out in this Policy.

Cookie Policy:

There are two types of Cookies used on our website:

Persistent Cookies: these are stored on your device after you have visited our website. These cookies help to enable us to identify you as a unique visitor.
